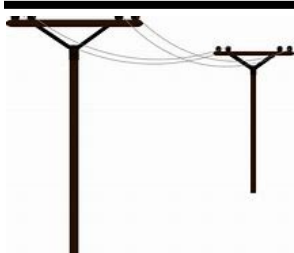

MYEC UPDATES—NOMINATING COMMITTEE & ANNUAL MEETING

The 2022 Nominating Committee members were picked by the board of trustees at the November and December meetings, and the names were then posted. The Nominating Committee will meet in early January at MYEC. At the time of this issue's publication, the date of the meeting had not been set.

The purpose of the Nominating Committee is to select candidates for the board of trustees. The cooperative members will have an opportunity to vote for candidates at the next annual meeting. The Committee consists of two members from District #2 (Myers, Tullock Creek, North Country-West of Ingomar) and District #5 (the East side of the system including North & East of Rosebud, Sweeney Creek, and the North end of Rosebud Creek) along with one member from each of the other 5 districts. The committee will nominate candidates for the two seats that are up for election. The present trustees holding seats in these districts are Tami Kimball (District #2) and Joe Schiffer (District #5). If you are a member of Mid-Yellowstone Electric Cooperative, a bona fide resident in District #2 or District #5, and are interested in becoming a candidate for the board of trustees, contact one of the Nominating Committee members and ask to be considered for nomination. The Board is in the planning stages of the March annual meeting and is discussing the various options that are available for a productive and safe meeting.
